

Chapter 16 - Protecting Door Inside & Behind Rear Seat (Video Clip 16)



544. Vacuum or blow out the door interior as much as possible. Wash out with a water hose and dry off with an air blower.



545. Vacuum or blow out the interior area behind the rear seat.



546. With a cheap throw-a-way brush paint POR 15 on the inside of the door as shown, to delay the rust.



547. Paint POR 15 on the inside of the rear quarter panel as shown.



548. Paint POR 15 on the interior area behind the rear seat as shown.



549. A few days later, add a second coat of POR 15 to all areas previously painted. After the body is painted, add a coat of undercoating prior to adding the padding and carpeting.
